CONSULTATIONS

The following consultation responses have been received since the preparation of the report:

<u>Highways</u>

"A revised scheme has been submitted that has reduced the number of parking spaces from 5 to 4.

Whilst, the previous scheme was considered acceptable as it was only one space below standard, this proposal will lose an additional space. There is very little on-street parking available in the vicinity of site due to the terrace properties and therefore a reduction in parking on this site will tend to increase parking pressures for existing residents.

Therefore, this revision to the scheme cannot be supported and a recommendation of refusal is made."

KEY ISSUES

The comments from the Head of Strategic Infrastructure relating to the revised plans are noted and no update to the original report is required, where these matters are dealt with in detail.

CONCLUSION

The recommendation remains as per the main agenda report as refusal for the reasons stated in the original report.
