## TO PROMOTE ALL FOUR LICENSING OBJECTIVES WE WILL KEEP:

Strong management controls and effective training of all staff so that they are aware of the premises license and the requirements to meet the four licensing objectives with particular attention to:

a/ No selling of Alcohol to underage people

b/ No drunk and disorderly behavior on the premises area

c/ vigilance in preventing the use and sale of illegal drugs at the retail area

d/ No violent and anti-social behavior

e/ No harm to children

- Operating schedule providing the hours of operation and licensable activities during those hours.
- Designated premises supervisor confimed it is obligated to be in day to day control of the premises, to provide good training for staff on the Licensing Act (Training Record), to make or authorize each sale.
- Clear "Challange 25" information to prevent the supply of alcohol to under-age drinkers.
- CCTV system installed with recording options available for upto 28 days.

As a licensed premises we know that it is necessary to carry out our functions and operate our business with a purpose of promoting these objectives. We promise to support these objectives through our operating scheduals and other measures (inclusing staff training and qualifications, policess and strategic partnerships with other agencies).

## b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The venue will be filled with a full colour CCTV system with a minimum recording play back of 28 days, covering all areas of the venue from multiple angles.

At peak trading times, a SIA accredited door supervisor will be on site, they will manage the dress code and control the numbers of customers in the venue as well as monitor and deal with and suspicious activity in a suitable manor. Comprehensive staff training surrounding the serving of alcohol.

Not selling alcohol to drunk or intoxicated customers.

## c) Public safety

A comprehensive health and safety policy will be in place, with associated risk assessments.

At peak trading times, a SIA accredited door supervisor will be on site.

Trained first aider on site at all times.

Trained fire marshal on site at all times.

Full emergency lighting and signage throughout the venue as well as a fire test log book.

A log book sgall be kept upon the premises in which shall be entered particlars (refusals log book) shall be kept available for inspection when required by persons authorized by the licensing act 2003.

All parts of the premises and all fittings and apparatus therein, door fastening and notices, lighting, heating, electrical, air conditioning, sanitary accommodation and other installations, will be maintained at all times in good order and in safe condition.

## d) The prevention of public nuisance

Exit signs will be placed to remind customers to leave in a quite manner and to respect the local neighbors.

(Friday / Saturday / Public holidays / Christmas eve / Boxing night / New Years Eve) SIA registered door supervisor will be on site to ensure the public entering and exiting the venue and behaving in a suitable manner.

No glass bottle bins will be emptied externally after 9pm or before 9am.

Mangers will ensure staff who arrive early morning or depart late at night when the business has ceased trading conduct themselves in such a manner to avoid disturbance to nearby residents.

## e) The protection of children from harm

acceptable ID (a card bearing a the PASS hologram, a photographic driving license or a passport) if they which to buy alcohol.

Under 18's must be accompanied by and adult at all times.

No under 18's will be allowed in the venue after 8pm. (The challenge 25 policy will also apply to entry to the premises) Staff to get full training on ID checking and a log book will be kept upon the premises at all times.

## **NOTES ON REGULATED ENTERTAINMENT**

In terms of specific **regulated entertainments** please note that:

- Plays: no licence is required for performances between 08:00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
- Films: no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
- Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
- Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
- Live music: no licence permission is required for:
  - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
  - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
  - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
  - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
  - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
  - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
  - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
  - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the
  audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains
  licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
  - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
  - o any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
  - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
  - o any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.


