13 SCHOOL TRANSPORT APPEALS

The Sub-Committee considered two appeals against the decision of the Cheshire East Transport Service not to allow assisted school transport in accordance with the Councils Under 16 Transport Policy (Case 1), and to the change in the Policy relating to pupils attending denominational schools (Case 2).

Case 1

The appellant attended the hearing. The Sub-Committee heard the appeal based on the appellant's written evidence and the oral and written evidence of the Presenting Officer who detailed the Local Authorities Case. Members of the Sub-Committee asked questions by way of clarification. The Presenting Officer and the appellant withdrew from the meeting following which the Sub-Committee reached its decision.
