Background:	The existing Creative Services contract expired on 15 April 2013. A new contract is required to ensure that Cheshire East Council continues to procure Creative Design and Print in line with EU procurement law.
	To meet the complex and diverse needs of the Council a multi provider option will offer greater flexibility whilst delivering a transparent and cost effective service.
	A framework agreement means that a contract can be awarded following a short mini competition process based on pricing and other information established in the original tender process thus giving confidence in value for money. Also, the range of suppliers appointed will collectively allow greater access to a wider range of services.
