<b>Reasons for the Decision and alternatives considered</b>	<p>For sewer repairs to be carried out it is necessary to close Maxwell Street, Crewe from the junction of Edleston Road to outside number 24.</p> <p><b>The alternative route</b> will be via Derrington Avenue, Edleston Road and visa versa which is considered the most suitable route.</p> <p>It is anticipated that the works will commence on Monday 24<sup>th</sup> April 2023 and will be completed by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May 2023.</p>
