11.0 Background and Options

11.1 At its meeting held on 3 June 2010, the Sustainable Communities Scrutiny Committee agreed to set up a Task and Finish Group to review the Community Safety Warden Service, to ensure that value for

- money was being achieved and services were not being duplicated. It was agreed that this work would be undertaken through a series of meetings and interviews with relevant stakeholders.
- 11.2 Cheshire East Council had inherited two existing warden services from Congleton Borough Council and Crewe and Nantwich Borough Council. Macclesfield Borough Council, on the other hand, had Environmental Enforcement Officers, who focused on the Clean Safer Neighbourhood Agenda and mainly dealt with fly tipping offences. As a result, a review had been undertaken by officers, to harmonise and integrate the existing services into one service that would be in a better position to deliver the objectives of Cheshire East Council.
