The policy shall require any person who appears to be under the age of 25 years to produce a recognised proof of age card, accredited under the Proof of Age Standards (Pass), or, if a proof of age card is not available, a photo driving licence or passport, to prove that they are over the age of 18 years. 3 - An incident book shall be kept at the premises. This shall be completed by management and staff to note down any incident of crime and disorder that takes place at the premises. This book shall be maintained and made readily available for inspection by Authorised Officers of the Police and Licensing Authority. 4 - No open vessels containing alcohol shall be removed from the premises other than to any designated area that has been set aside for the consumption of alcohol 5 - The outdoor areas shall be monitored by staff when it is in use and regularly cleared of glassware.
