	2- There shall be in place for the premises a Challenge 25 proof of age scheme to prevent the sale or supply of alcohol to persons under 18 years of age. The policy shall require any person who appears to be under the age of 25 years to produce a recognised proof of age card, accredited under the Proof of Age Standards (Pass), or, if a proof of age card is not available, a photo driving licence or passport, to prove that they are over the age of 18 years.
	3 – SIA registered Door Supervisors shall be employed at the Premises on Friday and Saturday evenings, along with Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve, to such a number as the management of the premises consider are sufficient to control the entry of persons to the premises and for the keeping of order in the premises when they are used for a licensable activity. When such staff are employed:
	A written record shall be kept on the premises by the Designated Premises Supervisor of every person employed on the premises as a door supervisor in a register kept for that purpose. That record shall contain the following details:-
	 The door supervisor's name, date of birth and home address; His/her Security Industry Authority licence number; The time and date he/she starts and finishes duty; The time of any breaks taken whilst on duty; Each entry shall be signed by the door supervisor. Record of all incidents taking place in the venue
	That register shall be available for inspection on demand by an Authorised Officer of the Council, the Security Industry Authority or a Police Constable. The SIA registered security staff shall ensure that persons enter and leave the premises in an orderly fashion.
	4 - No open vessels containing alcohol shall be removed from the premises other than to any designated area that has been set aside for the consumption of alcohol.
	5 – Tables and chairs shall be made available for all customers.

6 – Entry after 7pm on Friday and Saturdays shall be for over 21's only, unless dining on the first floor and accompanied by an adult.
