	<p><b><u>CONGLETON LANE, CHELFORD</u></b> From the junction of Holmes Chapel Road to the junction of Mill Lane.</p> <p><b><u>CONGLETON ROAD, NETHER ALDERLEY</u></b> South bound from junction of Chelford Road to Capesthorpe Hall Entrance.</p> <p><b>The following roads will have parking restriction in place 12:00 on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> July to 01:00 on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2025.</b></p> <p><b><u>BOLLINGTON LANE, NETHER ALDERLEY</u></b> For the full extent</p> <p><b><u>CONGLETON ROAD, NETHER ALDERLEY</u></b> For the junction with Chelford Road to the junction with Bollington Lane.</p> <p><b><u>CHELFORD ROAD, NETHER ALDERLEY</u></b> From outside the Lodge to the junction of Congleton Road.</p> <p><b><u>CHELFORD ROAD, CHELFORD</u></b> From the junction of Bollington Lane to the Junction of Congleton Road.</p> <p><b>The following roads will have a 30mph speed restriction in place 09:00 on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> July to 01:00 on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2025.</b></p> <p><b><u>CONGLETON ROAD, NETHER ALDERLEY</u></b> For the full extent.</p> <p><b><u>CONGLETON ROAD, SIDDINGTON</u></b> For the full extent.</p>
<b>Reasons for the Decision and alternatives considered</b>	<p>Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 provides the power to make orders preventing the obstruction of streets “in all times of public processions, rejoicings, or illuminations, and in any case when the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed.”</p> <p>The decision will enable the annual Hide &amp; Seek Festival to take place in a safe manner and to enable the police and authorised marshals to manage the event.</p>

	The Police have been consulted in relation to the event and have confirmed that they have no objection to the proposed order.
