

FORWARD PLAN 1 AUGUST 2011 - 30 NOVEMBER 2011

This Plan sets out the key decisions which the Executive expect to take over the next four months. The Plan is rolled forward every month. It will next be published in mid August and will then contain all key decisions expected to be taken between 1 September and 31 December 2011. Key decisions are defined in the Council's Constitution.
