Propose that 3DG1 gains approx. 100 electors from 3DH1, so 3DG1 will be approx. 1530 electors voting at Alderley Edge Festival Hall.

<u>3DH1</u> is approx. 900 electors voting at Alderley Edge Community Primary School.
Propose that 3DH1 gains approx. 310 electors from 3DF1. It also sends 100 electors to 3DG1, so 3DH1 will be approx. 1110 electors voting at Alderley Edge CP School.

Propose to split 4AD2 so that the west section becomes 4AD3. 4AD2 gains the east section of 4AD1. 4AD2 will now have approx. 1118 electors voting at Macclesfield cricket club.

<u>4AD3</u> new polling district created from the west section of 4AD2 and a section from 4AF1. 4AD3 will be approx. 1052 electors voting at Latter Day Saints Church.

<u>4AF1</u> has approx. 2452 electors voting at Broken Cross Methodist Church.

Propose split 4AF1 so the south section is 4AF1 and the north becomes new polling district 4AF3. A section also goes to 4AD3. 4AF1 will be approx. 764 electors voting at Broken Cross Methodist Church.

<u>4AF2</u> has approx 1942 electors voting at Upton Priory School. Propose no change to these arrangements.

Add part of COS4 and move Polling Station to Wellspring Methodist Church.

Propose to combine with COS2 to make one register continuing to vote at Mossley Village Hall.

Remainder of 1AD1 will be added to 68 electors from 1CE1, 224 electors from 1CF1 and 568 electors from 1CD1. This will create an updated polling district of 1AD1 to contain approx. 1410 electors voting at Community Learning Centre, 7/9 Coronation Street, Crewe. <u>1BD3</u> has approx. 787 electors voting at St Stephens Methodist Church Hall.

<u>1DE1</u> has approx. 2143 electors voting at Union Street Baptish Church.

Propose move all properties left of Westminster Street inclusive to 1BD3 to vote at St Stephens Church. 1DE1 to become one station at Union Street Baptist Church.

<u>1BA1</u> approx. 1940 electors voting at Wistaston Green Primary and Nursery School.

Propose that 1BA1 gains a section of approx. 125 electors from 1BD1 and approx. 45 electors from 1BC1.

Also propose to split 1BA1 in half up Moreton Road. This will form 2 polling districts: 1BA1 approx. 940 electors (which incorporates the sections gained from 1BD1 and 1BC1) and 1BAR approx. 1170 electors. Both voting at Wistaston Green Primary School.

Propose to move approx. 125 electors and send them to 1BA1.
