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Prior to the new Act, some 4/5 years ago, life for residents and other visitors was made miserable by the activities of several pubs, the White Horse being the principal offender, due to excessively noisy music.

Thanks to the efforts of the Council, the Environmental Health dept + by Inspector O'neilly of Nantwich police at the time, a proper curb on these activities was imposed.

For this the local residents were very grateful. Having experienced the relatively peaceful nights that ensued, as a result, they certainly have no intention of returning to the previous misery.
