

The opening hours and licensable activities are extended to 4:30 for Christmas day, Boxing Day and New Years Eve,and to 03:00 on each Sunday pre-ceeding a Bank Holiday Monday.

The supply of alcohol is extended to 04:00 for Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Years Eve and to 2:30 for each Sunday immediately pre-ceeding a Bank Holiday Monday.

- 1. No nuisance shall be caused by noise coming from the premises or by vibration transmitted through the structure of the building.
- 2. Refuse such as bottles shall be disposed of from the premises at a time (i.e between 8:00am to 8:00pm) when it is not likely to cause a disturbance to residents in the vicinity of the premises.
- 3 At all times the premises are open to the public there shall be on duty an adequate number of door supervisors who are registered with the Security Industry authority (SIA), the actual number decided by a written risk assessment which must be retained. Their details shall be recorded in a register which is retained for a minimum of 12 months and made available for inspection by an employee of the following organisations:- Police authority, Licensing Authority or SIA.
- 4. A tamper proof CCTV system shall be installed at the premises and be used to continuously record all areas inside and outside the premises.

- Images from the CCTV system shall be retained for a minimum of 31 days and copies made freely available on request to an employee of the following organisations:-Police Authority, Licensing Authority, Fire Authority, SIA.
- 6. CCTV equipment must be maintained in good working order in accordance with the manufacturers instructions.
- 7. The Premises Licence Holder and/or the Designated Premises
  Supervisor or a person nominated by them shall be a member of and
  regularly attend at the meetings of the Pubwatch scheme for the area
  within which the premises is located.
- The proof of age scheme "Challenge 21" will be operated for all sales of alcohol.
- 9. There shall be placed at all exits from the premises, in a place where they can be seen and easily read by the public, notices requiring customers to leave the premises and the area quietly.
- 10 No licensable activities shall be visible from outside the premises.
- All external doors and windows shall be kept closed, except in so far as is necessary to allow people access or egress in the event of an emergency.
- Notices shall be displayed at appropriate positions advising patrons not to open windows or doors except in an emergency.
- All fire doors shall be fitted with an alarm to ensure they are kept closed other than during an emergency.

# SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR LAP DANCING, STRIPTEASE AND RELATED ENTERTAINMENTS.

- Only entertainment, which has been specifically agreed in writing between the Premises Licence Holder and the Licensing Authority, shall take place.
- 15 There shall be no private performances of entertainment of an adult nature.
- There shall be no performances of entertainment of an adult nature in any area other than agreed with the Licensing Authority.
- 17 No person under 18 years of age shall be allowed to enter or remain on the premises at any time.
- 18. A notice stating "no persons under 18 will be admitted" shall be displayed prominently at the entrance to the premises.

- 19. Dressing rooms with adequate changing and washing facilities shall be provided.

  The Premises Licence Holder/Designated Premises Supervisor shall ensure that these area are not accessible by the Public at any time.
- 20. The Premises Licence holder/ Designated Premises Supervisor shall take all reasonable precautions and exercise due diligence to ensure the safety of the performers whilst on the premises and when leaving.
- 21. Adult themed entertainment shall only be given by the performers and no audience participation shall be permitted. In particular the performers **shall not:**
  - i Touch customers or be touched by customers in any way.
  - ii Approach closer than 30 cms (12 inches)
  - iii Perform with another dancer; or
  - iv Simulate sex acts

The Premises Licence holder/ Designated Premises Supervisor shall ensure that notices are clearly displayed in prominent positions showing condition (i) of the above.

- 22. Performers shall not take from or give to members of the public, telephone numbers, addresses or business cards, nor shall they solicit or make arrangements to meet members of the public.
- 23. Any person who touches or attempts to touch a performer or directs lewd, vulgar or obscene language or gestures therto shall be immediately removed from the premises.
- 24. The performers shall be fully dressed at all times when not taking part in the entertainment.
- 25. Any person who can be observed from outside the premises must be properly and decently dressed. Scantily clad individuals must not exhibit in the entrance way, windows or in the area surrounding the premises.
- 26. The Premises Licence Holder/ Designated Premises
  Supervisor must NOT display outside the premises any
  advertising material, photographs or other images that indicate
  and suggest that erotic dancing takes place on the premises.
- 27. The Premises Licence Holder/ Designated Premises Supervisor or Nominated Person agreed in writing with the Local Authority will be on the premises during any performance of an adult nature to ensure that these conditions are adhered to. A nominated female should be present to oversee the activities of the female performers and likewise a nominated male will be present to oversee the activities of any male performers.

- 28. A register of all performers including their names and addresses shall be maintained on the premises .The performers should sign to say that they have read and understood the conditions. The register shall also record the Premises Licence Holder/
  Designated Premises Supervisor or Nominated Person who was on duty during the times that a performance of an adult nature took place. This register should be maintained for a period of 12 months and should be available for inspection by an employee of the following organisations;- Police Authority, Licensing Authority.
- 29. No use on the premises of cameras or camera phones.
