Have your say – Macclesfield Community Governance Review

Following a decision by Cheshire East Council, a Community Governance Review will be conducted in Macclesfield. This review will consider how the unparished part of Macclesfield should be governed in the future. This could include no change; one or more town /parish councils; Neighbourhood Management; Residents' and Tenants' Associations; Community Forums; Community Associations or community development trusts. New arrangements would operate in addition to Cheshire East Council.

The following **public meetings** are being held to give local residents, organisations and groups the opportunity to find out what the Review means, and to inform people how to have their say on this important issue:

- **Monday 6th August, 3-5pm**, Macclesfield Town Hall (Capesthorne Room)
- **Tuesday 7th August, 7-9 pm**, Macclesfield Town Hall (Capesthorne Room)

Councillors involved with the Council's community governance review and Council staff will be present at the meetings to provide information and answer any questions you may have.

A first stage of formal consultation will take place during September when views from interested persons and organisations will be sought.
