Title: Local Choice Functions

1.0 Purpose of Report

1.1 To report to the Committee upon the subject matter of this report and to inform the Committee of the recommendations of Cabinet, which met on 6th January 2009.

These are set out in paragraph 8 of this report, in draft form (as the minutes were not formally approved at the time of preparation of this report).
- 7.3 The recommendations of the Governance and Constitution Committee will be reported to Council at its meeting on 24th February, following which the decision of Council will be embodied into the Council's Constitution Committee, which will take effect on Vesting Day.

8.0 Draft recommendation of Cabinet

That the Governance and Constitution Committee recommend to Council that:

- (1) With effect from Vesting Day, the allocation of local choice functions between Cabinet and the Council, and the further delegations to committees and officers, be as set out in the appendices to the report, subject to the Borough Solicitor being responsible for arrangements for questions at Council on Police Authority functions.
- (2) The Monitoring Officer be authorised to determine the remaining detail of the allocation of local choice functions in consultation with the Leader and appropriate Cabinet Members, and to make such amendments to the Council's emerging Constitution as he considers are necessary to give effect to the decision of Council.

9.0 Reasons for Recommendation

9.1 In order for the Council's Constitutional and decision-making arrangements to be agreed prior to Vesting Day.
