Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

- A CCTV system will be installed at the premises to the satisfaction of the Police Licensing Officer. It will record continuously during all hours that the premises are open to the public and unedited images will be securely stored for a period of at least 28 days. Copies from the CCTV system will be made freely available upon request to a constable or an employee of the Police Authority or Local Authority.
- 2 There shall be placed at all exits from the premises in a place where they can be seen and easily read by the public notices requiring customers to leave the premises and the area quietly.
- Where the premises provide food for consumption off the premises, the public area immediately surrounding the premises shall be cleared of waste food, food containers, wrapping etc regularly during the stated operating hours and at the end of trading on each day. Such refuse shall be placed in a container designed for the storage and disposal of refuse and waste foods which shall be constructed, maintained and located so that access to it by vermin and unauthorised persons is prevented and arrangements shall be made for the regular lawful disposal of their contents.
- 4 No nuisance shall be caused by noise coming from the premises.
