I am the above named person and I reside at the address stated overleaf.

I am self employed and have my own company BOSTON AND BOSTON and we provide doorknobs for various venues.

On the evening of Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2009 I was working on the front door of the WHITE HOLE Public house located on PILLOW STREET, NANTWICH.

At approximately 2300hrs the same day I was stood by the front door when I glanced into the bar and saw two males fighting near to the pool table. One male was on the floor and the other was stood over him and had hold of his throat with his right hand.

I went over and grabbed the male who was stood up. I would describe this male as, white, 19-21 years old, 5ft 9" tall with short dark hair and slim build. He was wearing a dark blue T-shirt, blue jeans and trainers. I didn't know him but I would recognise him if I saw him again.

I grabbed him from behind and pulled

him off the other male. He was struggling and he said "GET OFF ME OR I'LL SMASH YOUR HEAD IN, I'LL KILL YOU" he appeared to me to want to fight anybody. I told him that I was trying to help him but he continued to threaten me. After a few moments he calmed down and I let go of him. I then became aware of other incidents that were taking place in the pub, there was lots of shouting and fights breaking out so I used the town centre radio to ask for police assistance.

The same male, in the blue T shirt, then started to become aggressive again, shouting 'I'LL SMASH HIM, I'LL SMASH HIM' so I grabbed him around the chest to eject him from the pub. Someone then pulled my hand away loosening my grip. As I let go of the male, he raised his right arm and swung it back, elbowing me in the face. I heard a crack and at first thought he had broke my teeth.

I then grabbed him again and escorted him out of the pub through the front door. As we got outside, we were joined by a police officer. I explained to him that the male had assaulted me and what he had done.

I am Police Constable [REDACTED] of Cheshire Constabulary currently stationed at Nantwich.

About 11:40pm on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2009 I was on uniformed patrol duties in company with PC [REDACTED] when as a result of information received through the town centre link radio I made my way to The White Horse Pub on Pillory Street, Nantwich.

On arrival there was a large group with raised voices in the backyard area of the pub, it wasn't immediately clear what had happened but initial information was that 2 males had been fighting inside the pub the door supervisor had been struck at some point and there were by the time of our arrival about 20 people screaming, shouting and pointing at each other.

At this point I requested that other patrols should attend the pub due to the number of people inside, which was over 100 people several of whom were volatile. Numerous minor arguments and scuffles were happening around us and I spoke with the owner and told him to request everyone to leave. At this point I became aware of a drunken more mature woman who I now know to be [REDACTED] she seemed to be with another female who would seem to be her daughter, I recognised her as being one of the group who had been outside shouting, inside the

pub she was very unsteady on her feet, she had difficulty focusing her eyes and was slurring her speech, she was obviously very drunk. I heard her shouting at another blonde woman inside the pub it was apparent that she was very argumentative; she was repeatedly heard to say "FUCK OFF!" She was told to leave the pub numerous times, eventually the door supervisor escorted her

to the door area, she fell to the floor and seemed to struggle to get to her feet, she was wearing high heeled boots. Whilst sat in the doorway she shouted "FUCKING GET OFF ME! YOU CAN'T FUCKING DO THIS I'M 50 YEARS OLD." She was told numerous times by myself to calm down and stop swearing. Once outside she was strongly advised to leave the area and go home but she insisted on staying outside the pub and continued to shout obscenities at others outside. There were 20 – 30 people outside, approximately 10 of whom were very volatile.

[REDACTED] was again told to leave the area but refused to co-operate, stating "I'M A FUCKING 50 YEAR OLD WOMAN AND I HAVEN'T BEEN OUT FOR NEARLY A YEAR, THIS IS ALL FUCKING BOLLOCKS!" I then warned her that her behaviour was out of order, that she was aggravating an already volatile situation which was being further inflamed by her shouting and swearing. There were numerous members of public who were present in the street at this time, watching the chaos in the street.

I then again saw [REDACTED] stood near to [REDACTED] by the Police Car, I could hear that he was also warning her about her conduct, as I walked over to him, I saw that [REDACTED] had gently pushed [REDACTED] to guide her away from the area, she took offence to this lunged toward PC [REDACTED] with her hands raised to push him back shouting "FUCK OFF I'M GOING NOWHERE!" Due to her confrontational manner [REDACTED] put his hands up to push and keep her back, with this she stumbled backwards and fell over, at this point a group of about 5 others

approached aggressively and had to be pushed back and eventually restrained by other officers who had arrived at the scene. [REDACTED] was pulled to her feet and appeared uninjured, once stood up she again started to swear, shouting "YOU CAN'T FUCKING DO THIS TO ME, I'VE DONE FUCK ALL WRONG, IT'S A LOAD OF SHIT." At 11.55pm that same night, I then placed handcuffs on her to the front; she continued to swear and be argumentative throughout the whole process, due to her demeanour I informed her she was under arrest but did not caution her at that time. The arrest being necessary for a prompt and effective investigation. She was taken to Nantwich Police Station where the reasons for her arrest were properly outlined to her and she was cautioned to which she replied "IT'S ALL A FUCKING LOAD OF BOLLOCKS" She was searched at Nantwich Police Station, her jewellery was removed and all her property bagged and recorded accordingly. [REDACTED] was unco-operative, continuing to use foul language but less aggressive at Nantwich Police Station and numerous times asked why she had been arrested as she had done nothing wrong. Despite being told why she had been arrested she seemed oblivious to what had been said. [REDACTED] was handed to Reliance who assisted in her transportation to Middlewich Custody where her detention was authorised.

I am PC [REDACTED] of the Cheshire Constabulary currently based at Nantwich Police station.

On Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2009 at 23:40hrs I was on uniformed mobile patrol in company with PC [REDACTED], when as a result of information received via my personal radio, we attended The White Horse public house, Pillory Street, Nantwich to an ongoing disturbance. Upon arrival PC [REDACTED] and PC [REDACTED] were already present and dealing with numerous people who I would describe as very agitated. I assisted with diffusing the incident by speaking with persons involved.

At this time I was in the rear beer garden of the White Horse, I then saw PC [REDACTED] run into the pub, I followed her in to where two males were grabbing hold of each other, the two males were separated, the pub had approximately twenty people inside, most of which were shouting. A male member of staff then shouted for everyone to leave the pub, the pub is closed.

Before any further details could be taken of the two males, I was made aware of a further fight that had broken out near to the cigarette vending machine. The doorman who I

know to be [REDACTED] had taken hold of a female in a Leopard print top who I would describe as being aged in her fifties, I now know this female to be [REDACTED]. She was shouting and swearing at the group she had been pulled off and at the doorman. As [REDACTED] was being ejected from the pub I directed a female in a black top who was with [REDACTED] to the door, [REDACTED] was resisting and struggling with the doorman. <sup>The doorman</sup> [REDACTED] left the female at the door of the pub as he went back inside. [REDACTED] was very unsteady on her feet and very loud, in my opinion she was drunk. [REDACTED] was stood in the door way when she then fell to the ground, she sat in the doorway. The younger female in the black top shouted "GET UP MUM" [REDACTED] refused to get up, she was blocking the exit to the pub, I picked [REDACTED] up under her arm pits and assisted her to her feet she then stood and started to shout at me and at the group inside the pub. I said to [REDACTED] and her daughter to leave the area and go home, [REDACTED] shouted at me "OR FUCKING WHAT" I then warned [REDACTED] that if she continued to shout and swear she would be arrested. [REDACTED] made her way away from the pub, but then turned back and came back towards the pub and started to shout at the people that were now leaving the pub. Again I directed [REDACTED] away from the pub. At this time I would estimate there to be in the region of 30 – 40 people outside the pub on Pillory Street and arguments were starting in numerous places. I then went to assist with other groups. The atmosphere of the groups in the street was very hostile and had the potential to cause a large scale disorder.

I saw that PC [REDACTED] had a male in a blue T shirt in handcuffs, the males shirt was torn and he was shouting "GET THE FUCK OFF ME" and "WHAT THE FUCK YOU

DOING" he was resisting PC [REDACTED] so I went to assist. The female [REDACTED] and her daughter came back over shouting "WHY HAS HE BEEN ARRESTED?" I turned to them and said "MOVE AWAY" and blocked them from grabbing hold of the arrested male. The male was placed into the rear of the marked Police vehicle [REDACTED] I then went over to another group of males who I know to be [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. These males were all shouting and swearing, although I can not say who was saying what. I heard [REDACTED] shout "FUCKING PIGS".

The males were warned to stop shouting and swearing and leave the area. I then saw the female [REDACTED] trying to get to the male in the rear of the Police vehicle. PC [REDACTED] was stood by the door, [REDACTED] said "WHATS HE BEEN ARRESTED FOR IT WASN'T EVEN HIM, HE'S MY NEPHEW" I told [REDACTED] "MOVE AWAY, I DON'T KNOW WHY HE HAS BEEN ARRESTED I" at this time she said "OH FUCK OFF" I then pushed her away from the vehicle, keeping my hands in contact with her arm and shoulder, she said "GET THE FUCK OFF ME" [REDACTED] then tried to push me on the chest and then swing with her hands in the direction of my face. I extended my arms outwards to lock them to keep a distance from [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] then stepped backwards and then fell onto her back, she seemed to lose her footing on either guttering or kerb stone as she went backwards. The group of males then erupted further as the female fell over and started to charge forwards. I stepped past the female who was sitting up, to prevent her from being trampled by the forwarding group, the group were shouting "YOU HAVE JUST PUNCHED HER" I then was joined by other officers who were

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assisting to restrain the group; one of them being [REDACTED] I turned to see the female was stood with PC [REDACTED]. Numerous Police officers were then in attendance restraining [REDACTED]. I assisted with PC [REDACTED] and PC [REDACTED] to then place [REDACTED] into a waiting Police van cell. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was calm as he was being walked to the Police vehicle but then would not sit on the seat in the cell, he said "I WILL SIT ON THE FLOOR WHO'S GOING TO MAKE ME COME AND TRY IT AND SEE WHAT HAPPENS" [REDACTED] was again told to calm down and sit on the seat he did so in a reluctant manner but then started to head butt the cell wall, PC [REDACTED] grabbed hold of [REDACTED] to prevent him from causing himself harm. PC [REDACTED] then left the cell and the door was closed. [REDACTED] could be heard shouting and swearing and hitting the cell walls.

I went back to the Police vehicle where I and PC [REDACTED] went to get into the vehicle with the prisoner I now know to be [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] had been sick on the rear seats of the Police vehicle, the rear door was opened where [REDACTED] said "I'M SORRY I WILL CLEAN IT UP"

The male was taken to Nantwich Police station where he was then transported to custody.

At 01:30hrs Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> April 2009, I took a digital photograph of the damage to the rear of the Police car [REDACTED] which I now produce in evidence as (Police Reference CMH/1) (Court Exhibit ).

I am Police Constable 4933 [REDACTED] of the Cheshire Constabulary currently stationed at Nantwich Police Station.

On Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2009 I was in full uniform on mobile patrol in company with PC

[REDACTED] At approximately 23:40hrs we attended The White Horse public house, Pillory Street, Nantwich, regarding a disturbance that had been reported.

At this time I went along the side of the pub and in through the rear door, several members of the public then directed me towards the front door where I could see a male, I now know to be [REDACTED], who was being ejected by a member of the doorstaff. I could see that [REDACTED] was struggling with the doorman as they walked through the pub.

I followed them out of the front door and onto Pillory Street where [REDACTED] continued to be aggressive and was being verbally abusive to both me and the Doorman, [REDACTED]. He shouted "GET THE FUCK OFF ME, OR YOU'RE FUCKED" and "I'LL FUCKING HAVE ALL OF YOU"

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I then took hold of [REDACTED] arm and warned him about his behaviour and swearing. Due to his glazed eyes and being unsteady on his feet I formed the opinion that [REDACTED] was very drunk.

[REDACTED] then informed me that [REDACTED] was being aggressive in the pub and when he went to eject him, [REDACTED] elbowed him in the face. I could see that [REDACTED] had blood coming from his mouth and he told me that he thought some of his teeth were loose or broken

I took [REDACTED] to the side of the pub, away from [REDACTED] in an attempt to calm him down.

At 23:50hrs the same day I took [REDACTED] to our marked police vehicle (vrm [REDACTED]) [REDACTED] parked on Pillory Street, where I said to him "YOU ARE UNDER ARREST ON SUSPICION OF ASSAULT" and cautioned him, to which he replied "WHAT THE FUCK YOU DOIN' I DIDN'T FUCKIN HIT ANYONE". I then handcuffed [REDACTED] to the front and placed him in the rear of the police vehicle and informed him that the reason for his arrest was for the prompt and effective investigation of the offence and to prevent physical injury. He continued to be aggressive shouting "WHAT THE FUCK" over and over again and he headbutted the rear windows of our vehicle several times.

Once [REDACTED] was secured I left the vehicle to help other officers who were restraining another arrested male on the floor in the street. I assisted PC [REDACTED] with applying handcuffs to this male.

On returning to our police vehicle shortly after I could see that [REDACTED] appeared to be spitting on the rear seat, when the door was opened I could see that he had

vomited all over the rear seat and so told him "YOU'RE ALSO UNDER ARREST FOR CRIMINAL DAMAGE" and cautioned him to which he replied "I'M SORRY, I'LL CLEAN IT UP".

Myself and PC [REDACTED] then conveyed [REDACTED] to Nantwich Police Station

where he was handed over to Reliance for transportation to Middlewich Custody Facility.

I am Police Constable [REDACTED] of the CHESHIRE  
Constabulary currently stationed within CREWE targeted patrol team.

On Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2009 I was on full uniformed mobile patrol when as a result of a message I received via my airwave terminal I attended outside of THE WHITE HORSE, PILLORY STREET, NANTWICH where it was reported by police officers in attendance that there was a large disturbance in the street and they required more patrols.

Upon my arrival at the location I could see a large number of people outside the location all of whom were shouting loudly.

As I approached the large disturbance my attention was drawn to a tall well built male, who I now know to be [REDACTED]. I could

see that [REDACTED] was standing on his tip-toes and was bouncing up and down, side to side with his arms outstretched in a fighting stance. He appeared aggressive and I could see that he was approaching another officer who was currently dealing with someone else, and was kneeling on the floor with his back towards [REDACTED]. I do not recall who this officer was.

[REDACTED] was shouting "YOU'RE FUCKING OUT OF ORDER, YOU'RE ALL FUCKING BULLIES". He approached the officer and I saw the officer stand, turn to face him and push him away telling him clearly to 'GET BACK'. [REDACTED] replied "WHAT THE FUCK ARE YOU GOING TO DO" and approached the officer again, who had again kneeled back by the other person.

[REDACTED] manner was aggressive and he continued to shout and swear saying "YOU'RE FUCKING OUT OF ORDER" on several occasions. As I continued to approach I saw members of the public who I believed to be [REDACTED] friends trying to push him away and persuade him to leave. This was unsuccessful and he continued to try to push past them and to get towards the officer who had initially warned him. I believed that had he got close enough to the officer then he would try to assault him.

Due to this fact I approached [REDACTED] who squared up to me a few feet away from me and outstretched his arms. He is very tall and I believe that he was trying to intimidate me by standing over me. He continued to shout in an aggressive manner

and I again told him to 'GET BACK AND GO AWAY'. He ignored this warning.

There were a large number of people in the street, some of whom were elderly watching the fracas.

Believing that he may try to assault me, his aggressive behaviour, his fighting stance that he had currently adopted and the fact that [REDACTED] was trying to approach the other officer, for mine and the other officers safety I pushed [REDACTED] back away from me and clearly saying again "GET BACK AND CALM DOWN OR YOU WILL BE ARRESTED". [REDACTED] said again "WHAT THE FUCK ARE YOU GOING TO DO".

[REDACTED] continued to bounce on his toes in an aggressive manner still maintaining a fighting stance. He was warned a further few times to go away or he would be arrested, which he ignored and continued to shout "YOUR FUCKING OUT OF ORDER, WHAT THE FUCK ARE YOU GOING TO DO".

I then took the decision to arrest [REDACTED] and at 23:50 hours I said to him "YOU ARE UNDER ARREST FOR SECTION 5 PUBLIC ORDER", taking hold of his

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right hand in an attempt to handcuff him. I saw PC [REDACTED] who had arrived at the same time as myself, take hold of [REDACTED] other arm. My reason for arresting [REDACTED] was to enable a prompt and effective investigation into the offence, prevent injury or damage to others and property.

[REDACTED] immediately became violent and began to try to pull away, he was shouting aggressively although I do not recall what he was saying. [REDACTED] was very strong and I struggled to maintain a grip on him and control him. I feared at that time that should I lose my grip on his arm then I would be assaulted.

I continued to try to maintain a grip on [REDACTED] arm and was still unable to apply handcuffs due to him struggling violently. Myself and PC [REDACTED] then took [REDACTED] to the floor, during this we have fallen over the officer that was kneeling on the floor and the person that he was with.

[REDACTED] landed on his back on top of the other person facing up towards me shouting "FUCKING DICKS" in an aggressive and threatening manner. I have then managed to apply a single handcuff to [REDACTED] right hand. I attempted to maintain a grip on the handcuff already applied and was unable to release his other hand to apply the remaining handcuff. I was continually shouting loudly and clearly

"RELEASE YOUR ARM NOW". He refused to comply and continued to struggle violently.

I then became aware of a member of door staff to my right hand side who assisted in trying to free [REDACTED] other arm, which would of allowed me to apply a second handcuff securing [REDACTED]. After a few minutes [REDACTED] still refused to comply and the member of door staff was able to take hold of [REDACTED] remaining hand, pulling it across his front allowing me to apply the remaining handcuff, as he still struggled violently.

I then stood [REDACTED] to his feet with PC [REDACTED] and escorted him on foot away from where the main fracas was occurring back towards our police vehicle for our safety. Whilst walking to the vehicle [REDACTED] continued to be abusive and resist us, struggling. He turned to face me suddenly still shouting and swearing at me. From the movement of his head I believed that he was going to spit on me and pushed his head towards the floor. I then said again to [REDACTED] "YOU ARE UNDER ARREST FOR SECTION 5 PUBLIC ORDER". I then cautioned him to which he replied "DICKHEADS". Due to his aggressive and violent behaviour I did not explain the necessity for arrest.

When we reached the vehicle due to [REDACTED] still struggling and shouting and swearing he was again taken to the floor allowing us to gain control much more safely for both ourselves and [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] was placed face down on the floor and I continued to hold his handcuffs as he kept trying to lash out at officers. He continued to say "YOU'RE ALL FUCKING OUT OF ORDER, FUCKING DICKHEADS".

When we took [REDACTED] to the floor he was on the pavement to the rear of the police vehicle. I then saw a male who I now know to be [REDACTED] walking down the pavement towards ourselves. I told [REDACTED] to get back as at that time I was unaware whether he was a friend of [REDACTED] and could be approaching us whilst we were on the floor. [REDACTED] would have had to step over us to get past along the pavement. He did not comply with this request and continued to walk towards us. I again told him to get back and go another way. He did not reply he just continued to walk towards me looking at us. PC [REDACTED] then told [REDACTED] to get back and I heard [REDACTED] reply "YOU'RE ALL FUCKING BULLIES, ARSEHOLES". I then saw PC [REDACTED] stand up and approach [REDACTED].

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As PC [REDACTED] stood to his feet [REDACTED] again became violent and managed to knock me off balance and turn onto his front. I then managed to get my balance and restrain him again, with the aid of the member of door staff.

[REDACTED] then said to me "YOU'RE A FUCKING LITTLE PRICK, IF YOU TAKE THESE HANDCUFFS OFF I'LL BREAK YOUR FUCKING JAW". At this stage Sgt [REDACTED] arrived and applied limb restraints to [REDACTED] legs, due to the fact that he was still struggling. [REDACTED] then said "I KNOW WHAT I'VE DONE IS WRONG AND I DESERVE TO GET LOCKED UP BUT WHAT THEY DID TO HER WAS WRONG".

[REDACTED] then started to shout "HE'S SQUEEZING MY CUFFS, GET HIM FUCKING OFF ME". I advised [REDACTED] that I was not squeezing his cuffs and I was holding the bar in the centre of them, again telling him to calm down. I then spoke to his female friend who agreed that I was correct and tried to get him to calm down and stop struggling.

[REDACTED] then became more compliant being only verbally aggressive and was sat upright leaning his back against my leg for support. The marked personnel carrier then arrived and he was placed into the rear. As soon as he was placed into the cell at the rear of the van he began to headbutt the cage door. Initially I got into the cell in an

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attempt to stop him from hurting himself and to calm him down. I restrained him by holding him back against the wall that he had his back against.

He continued to struggle and be violent and would not calm down despite repeated requests from myself. I then withdrew from the cell as I feared that should I remain in the van then I would be injured.

PC [REDACTED] then drove the vehicle, followed by myself to the East Cheshire Custody Facility where [REDACTED] detention was authorised.

Upon arrival at the custody suite he continued to be abusive and un-cooperative, resulting in him being taken to the cell and strip searched by myself, PC [REDACTED] and other police officers and detention staff. Also whilst at custody at 00:30 hours on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2009 I further arrest [REDACTED] for resisting arrest and reminded him that he was still under caution. He chose to make no further reply.

As a result of [REDACTED] struggling and resisting the arrest I have sustained grazing and a small cut to my left elbow. [REDACTED]

I am PC [REDACTED] of the Cheshire Constabulary stationed at CREWE. At approximately 11.50 pm on SATURDAY 25th APRIL 2009, I was on mobile Patrol duties in full uniform when I attended the area of RIVERS STREET, NANTWICH after requests from another officer for more officers due to a disturbance.

On arrival I could see that there was a lot of people on the street and as I got out of my vehicle I could hear a lot of shouting going on. As I moved towards a large group I saw a male who I recognised as a [REDACTED] [REDACTED] his arms around and moving back and forth in an aggressive manner, and I could hear [REDACTED] shout "YOUR FUCKING OUT OF ORDER, YOUR FUCKING BULLIES", and was pushed back by another officer who was trying to deal with another incident and he said "WHAT THE FUCK ARE YOU GOING TO DO" and continually acted aggressively.

At this time I saw PC [redacted] approach [redacted] and he immediately went towards him saying "WHAT THE FUCK ARE YOU GOING TO DO"

At this I saw PC [redacted] push [redacted] back the way but [redacted] continued to act in an aggressive manner swinging his arms around.

PC [redacted] warned [redacted] about the way he was behaving and then arrested him for Public order and [redacted] immediately started to kick off and I assisted PC [redacted] by taking hold of [redacted] left arm.

At this [REDACTED] went round but stopped and said "YOUR ARE FUCKING BULLIES ARSEHOLE".

I then stood up at this time as [REDACTED] turned to start walking away as I went and got hold of him and said "YOU ARE UNDER ARREST FOR SECTION 5 PUBLIC ORDER" & cautioned him, as I
