Annex 1 - Mandatory Conditions (as applicable)

- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made under this Premises Licence
 - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the Premises Licence, or
 - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a Personal Licence or his Personal Licence is suspended.
- 2. Every supply of alcohol under this Premises Licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a Personal Licence.

Where a Village Hall is exempt from needing DPS under s.19 Licensing Act 2003

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by the Management Committee.

Mandatory condition where the licence authorises the exhibition of films

The admission of children to the exhibition of any film must be restricted in accordance with section 20 of the Licensing Act 2003. Admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by the British Board of Film Classification or the Licensing Authority.

Prohibited conditions: plays

- 1. In relation to a premises licence which authorises the performance of plays, no condition may be attached to the licence as to the nature of the plays which may be performed, or the manner of performing plays, under the licence.
- 2. But subsection (1) does not prevent a licensing authority imposing, in accordance with section 18(2)(a) or (3)(b), 35(3)(b) or 52(3), any condition which it considers necessary on the grounds of public safety.

Mandatory condition: Door supervision

Each individual engaged in security activities at the premises must either:

- a) be authorised to carry out that activity by a licence granted under the Private Security Industry Act 2001; or
- b) be entitled to carry out that activity by virtue of Section 4 of the Private Security Industry Act 2001.

LICENSING ACT 2003 (MANDATORY LICENSING CONDITIONS)(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2014

MANDATORY CONDITIONS

Condition 1

- 1. The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises no not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
- 2. In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises:
 - a) Games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage individuals to
 - i. Drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - ii. Drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);

- b) Provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
- c) Provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period fo 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
- d) Selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner:
- e) Dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of disability).

Condition 2

The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

Condition 3

- 1. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- 2. The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.
- 3. The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either
 - a) A holographic mark, or
 - b) An ultraviolet feature

Condition 4

The responsible person must ensure that -

- a) Where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures
 - i. Beer or cider: 1/2 pint;
 - ii. Gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25ml or 35ml; and
 - iii. Still wine in a glass: 125ml;
- b) These measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and
- c) Where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.

The Licensing Act 2003 (Mandatory Licensing Conditions) Order 2014

- A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
- For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1
 - a) 'duty' is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;
 - b) 'permitted price' is the price found by applying the formula-

$$P = D + (D \times V)$$

Where -

i. P is the permitted price,

ii. D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and iii. V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol:

- c) 'relevant person' means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence—
 - the holder of the premises licence,
 - ii. the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - iii. the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;
- d) 'relevant person' means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
- e) 'valued added tax' means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.
- Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
- 4. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.
 - (2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.



I am writing in respect to the application made under Licencing section 34 by Morrisons Supermarkets to extend their opening hours form the current 0700-2200 to 0600-2400 Monday to Saturday.

L. V. P.

I object to the further extension of trading hours at this supermarket as I live on the opposite side of the road and would have to tolerate the additional noise, disruption and illumination were it permitted.

When I first moved to my current address, Morrisons was open 8am to 8pm. Aldi across the way was open only until 6pm and we greatly appreciated the peace that pervaded once the supermarkets closed of an evening. When both supermarkets extended their hours to 10pm it was an unwelcome suprise which now means we have continuous vehicle movements right up to the end of the evening. To extend this to midnight is unnecessary and will affect us directly at night when we would likely prefer to be sleeping. It also has the potential to disrupt the sleeping patterns of our infant child. We already regularly hear revellers returning from an evening out, but these are fortunately brief episodes given that there is no facility nearby which might invite them to stay around longer. With Morrisons open until midnight we would undoubtedly have to put up with groups of intoxicated people hanging around outside having picked up late night snacks from the supermarket.

Morrisons is already the defacto takeaway on this side of town with large numbers of school children treating the hot chicken counter like a KFC at lunchtimes and after school. Granting this licence extension will effectively extend their takeway facilities to cater for the post-pub crowd. As it is, Morrisons take no responsibility for cleaning up after their takeaway patrons. Were there a McDonalds in town they would be required to contribute to street cleaning as they do in other towns across the country.

As well as night hours, there is the unwelcome prospect of being woken before dawn (well certainly before the alarm clock goes off) by the traffic resulting from yet more opportunities to shop across the road.

Nantwich is a vibrant town in part because it has a a healthy resident town centre population. There is generally a nice balance between the commercial demands made of the town and the ability for residents to enjoy the town after the shops have closed. It has a real village feel, especially on Sunday afternoons when the supermarkets are forced to close and the traffic is allowed to die away. Steady erosion of these less stressful hours will only lead to residents leaving the town centre and Nantwich become an empty shell at nights.

I would also urge the council to reject any application which might be made in future in respect of extended Sunday trading laws that this government seems likely to permit at a future date.
