- Public Transport network development and support
- Managing and operating concessionary travel scheme
- Fleet management, assets and infrastructure

- Transitional Shared Service with CWaC
- Based at Rivacre, Ellesmere Port
- £52.6m gross budget
- Managed through Strategic Highways + Transportation Team within Regeneration Service
- Review to commence Nov 09 to inform future arrangements

ITS Review: Outcomes.

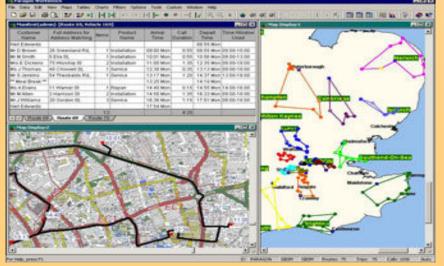


- A market tested Integrated Transport solution that is 'fit for purpose' for delivering Cheshire East's transportation requirements in a cost effective way
