I write with reference to the application for licensable activities at Hilltop Farm, Aston By Budworth, on 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> August 2016.

I must object to this application in the strongest possible terms.

I am a local resident with a young family living some 500 metres from the farm. The proposal for music until 4am and alcohol being served until 3:30am is totally unacceptable and in my view completely unnecessary.

I am concerned as to loud music being played until well into the morning but also alcohol being served in a rural location until 3:30am. This application would certainly not be permitted in an urban area and I see no reason why it should be granted in a rural area. Event curfews in urban are normally 11pm from my experience.

One wonders what measures the police are taking to ensure that there isn't anti-social drunken behaviour usually associated with such long licencing hours or indeed to ensure that there is no drink driving or crime emanating from such an event.

I strongly request that permission is NOT granted for this event.
