Reference: Public Entertainment (Premises) Licence – Bridgemere Lane

Dear Sir or Madam,

I am writing to register in the strongest terms my objections to the application for an entertainment licence on agricultural land on Bridgemere Lane near to Pewit Lane. My reasons are as follows:

- Fundamentally this is an inappropriate location for such activities it being agricultural land with no relevant infrastructure, buildings or toilets.
- It would mean open-air amplified music which would result in significant noise and disturbance to the residents of this quiet and peaceful area.
- It would result in unacceptable volumes of traffic on the narrow country lanes allied with inadequate access for policing and emergency vehicles.
- The potential use of fireworks will cause noise, pollution, disturbance to wildlife and domestic animals, as well as a fire risk to local properties.
- There would be a significant increase in the risk of crime, anti-social behaviour, opportunistic burglary or trespass, as well as alcohol and drug use.
- There would be a detrimental impact on wildlife and nesting birds from the disturbance, litter and pollution
