- 4. Residents leaving properties during events to get away from the noise presents an opportunity for burglaries to take place or access to the rear of properties in the area to plan future burglaries.
- 5. Prospects for young people leaving the event walking narrow lanes at night possibly under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs.

CONCLUSION

We believe this application breaches all four of the licensing objectives:

- · Prevention of Crime and disorder
- Public Safety
- Prevention of Public Nuisance
- Protection of Children from Harm

We have been informed that the events will be family orientated; we do not understand how this can possibly be controlled.

Put simply this proposal as a repetitive event location is ill considered, out of context with the area and will have a significant adverse impact on residents and wildlife.
