I met with the applicant for the above premises licence, and his representatives, on Thursday 28th January 2010 and agreed the following three conditions which should be attached to the premises licence in order to promote the licensing objectives:

- 1. A maximum capacity limit of 1,500 people present on the premises will be observed at all times licensable activities are taking place.
- 2. Licensable activities may only take place on the premises during a maximum of two days in any calendar year.
- 3. The premises licence holder must give written notice to the Licensing Authority and the Chief Officer of Police* of any planned licensable activities which are to take place on the premises. This notice must be received by the Licensing Authority and Chief Officer of Police* at least 28 clear days before the licensable activities are to take place. The copy sent to the Chief Officer of Police* must include a copy of the event operating schedule and, if not already included in that document, risk assessments, health and safety plan, traffic plan and evacuation procedure.
