I have considered the above application and wish to object under the licensing objective of:

**The prevention of public nuisance**

This application is for the provision of entertainment in a marquee on the car park of the premises from 8pm until 3am. The car park backs onto numerous residential properties and there will be very little in terms of sound attenuation offered by the marquee. Hence a potential 7 hours of music until the early hours of the morning, when people will be trying to sleep, is excessive and would fail to meet the licensing objective of the prevention of public nuisance.

It is important to note that Environmental Health have received complaints previously from local residents, about events held at the White Horse and particularly noise from people in the outside area.

Consequently Environmental Health must object to the granting of the Temporary Event Notice under the licensing objective of the prevention of public nuisance.
