Condition:

A CCTV system shall be used and shall be designed and installed in accordance with the Cheshire Constabulary's CCTV guidance document called 'CCTV in Licensed Premises – An Operational Requirement'. (Provided) This system shall be in operation at all times when licensable activities are taking place.

Further, to prove such a system is fit for purpose, complies with other legislation and can be operated satisfactorily,

Condition:

Designated Supervisors and Premises Licence Holders shall need to ensure the following:-

- 1) recordings are fit for their intended purpose,
- 2) good quality images are presented to the officer in a format that can be replayed on a standard computer,
- 3) the supervisor has an understanding of the equipment/training,
- 4) management records are kept,
- 5) maintenance agreements and records are maintained,
- 6) Data Protection principles and signage are in place.

All other steps offered are welcome and acceptable to the Police and will assist in promoting all four objectives of the Act.
