Many thanks for your recent email regarding Wilmslow Rugby Club.

I have had several residents from Kings Road, Carrwood Road & Woodlands Road who have contacted me recently but I replied to them that no application for a change of premises licence had been made to Cheshire East Council licensing department.

However, I have just had confirmation that Wilmslow Rugby Club have now applied for a premises licence "to permit the sale of alcohol & provision of regulated entertainment from 1100hrs to 2300hrs Monday & Wednesday, 1100hrs to 00.00hrs Tuesday & Thursday, 1100hrs to 0100hrs Friday & Saturday and 1200hrs to 2230hrs on Sundays, all plus 30 minutes dispersal".
