We wish to oppose the application for a new Premises Licence by Wilmslow Rugby Club for the following reasons

1. The increased traffic late at night and more cars parked on our road will lead to much noise and general disturbance in a quiet suburban area.
2. Heavy lorries will have to access the site to deliver and collect stages, sound systems etc. for these outdoor events and this will cause damage to Kings Road and the properties on it.
3. There will be potential for increased burglary and property damage as thousands of non-local drunk people deposit.
4. The Rugby Club is bordered on two sides by the Bollin Valley - a tranquil beauty spot with much wildlife. The peace there will be shattered by loud music from the outdoor events.
