Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to OBJECT to Wilmslow Rugby Club application for a Premises Licence.

As a resident of [REDACTED], I feel the location of the club does not facilitate the number of vehicles needed to transport equipment needed for any large-scale events. King's Road is a quiet, residential road with a 20mph speed limit and a 7.5T weight limit.

I understand the club has a club premises certificate at present. Whilst no events have been held inside the clubhouse over the past 15 months, when a member does hold a private party at the club, we can hear the music in our house on [REDACTED].

Any outside events held if the Premises Licence is granted will be of great disruption to the local residents in terms of traffic, noise, vehicle pollution and general disturbance of what is a quiet residential area.

It turns a rugby club into an outdoor music venue and this is not the place for this due to the location to a large number of houses.
