I refer to the above application. I object to the Rugby Club extending their licence mainly because of the extra noise it will create. I live about 1/4 mile from the Club and can hear the loud music when they hold their current events, especially at night time. The people that live closer must find it unbearable. We accept and put up with the current noise as it is not very often, so this is not NIMBYism. When I moved here, in [REDACTED] I accepted that a local rugby club might have the occasional event/end of season disco etc. I object to any addition to current levels and object to the imposition of, in effect, a full blown entertainments venue, which it was not designed to be. This would not be in keeping with the neighbourhood. This move is designed obviously to bring in extra revenue for the Rugby Club. I am also concerned that the following will be prejudiced if the premises licence is granted:-

Prevention of crime and disorder
Public safety
Vandalism
Prevention of public nuisance

I urge you please to decline the application.
