To whom it may concern,

I am writing to protest against the application of WRC to change their 'club premises certificate' into a 'premises licence' to hold events such as 'Party on the Pitch', planned for July 3rd 2021 with 'Licensed Open Air Bars.'

My objection is with several factors in mind:

- 1) Prevention of public nuisance- I am concerned about the number of people these events will attract, and the noise/traffic/parking issues involved on such a quiet street with no thoroughfare- therefore disturbing the peace of the area, causing general public nuisance.
- 2) Crime and disorder, including risk of vandalism- a known potential risk with large groups of people especially where alcohol is involved. This is a peaceful street surrounded by beautiful areas of nature (such as The Carrs and Lindow Common), which risks being spoiled by crowds of people and the noise/litter/traffic this will generate.
- 3) Public safety and protection of residents (including children) from harm- late night events with alcohol involved risk this.

I would be grateful if you would take these considerations in mind when making your decision on the application.
