DRAFT POLICE AND CRIME PLAN: 2021-2024

Thank you for attending the meeting of the Police and Crime Panel on Friday 24th September and for outlining the priorities contained in your draft Police and Crime Plan. The Panel welcomed the overall approach adopted in your draft Plan, but would make the following observations:

- (i) Whilst recognising both the role played by your Public Scrutiny Board where detailed performance information is reviewed, and your ongoing and detailed scrutiny of the Chief Constable, it was felt that the Plan would benefit from the inclusion of some measurable objectives.
- (ii) There should be a clearer focus on how violence against women and girls will be reduced.
- (iii) Consideration should be given to the inclusion in the Plan of more challenging climate change targets; specifically, those relating to carbon neutrality.
- (iv) The Plan would benefit from a clear unambiguous statement as to how you as Commissioner, working with the Chief Constable and the wider Constabulary, will work collaboratively with strategic partners to ensure a more joined up approach to the delivery of services and consequential improvements to community safety across Cheshire.

I look forward to hearing from you and to reading the final version of this very important document.
