Apologies for the delay in getting back to you, but I have been extremely busy today. We wrote to Tony on the 27th July, amending the application to a terminal hour for all licensable activity to be 23:00, therefore regulated entertainment would no longer be applied for. Instore music would therefore be permitted up until 23:00 hours without licensable permission, given the deregulation of live and recorded music. In light of this conditions numbers: 3, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 are acceptable. Numbers 1, 5, 6 7, 12, become redundant as regulated entertainment is not applied for. (7 cannot be measured as it is subjective, and would depend on the interpretation of the individual. We do not accept condition number 2 as the applicant wishes to create mood music by way of example a double bass, on occasion. This could be conditioned to only apply whilst the premises is owned and operated by the applicant, to preserve future risk. We cannot accept condition 4 in its present form as this could very well become a health risk to customers. As far as 13 is concerned, the premises does not have a car park.
