6 July 2023	<p><b>Appointment of Members to Exclusions Appeals Panel</b></p> <p>The Council had received a request for an independent review hearing to be held in accordance with s.51A of the Education Act 2002 and The School Discipline (Pupil Exclusions and Reviews) Regulations 2012.</p> <p>The Council had a pool of lay members who were eligible to sit on the independent review panel for exclusions. However, on this occasion none of the lay members were available.</p> <p>The Constitution required panel members to be appointed by the Corporate Policy Committee. However, there was not a scheduled meeting of the Committee within the required timescale. It was therefore necessary to appoint up to three members from neighbouring authorities.</p> <p><b>Decision</b></p> <p>To appoint up to three lay members (who shall not be Councillors) from neighbouring authorities to sit on the independent review panel.</p>	Corporate Policy Committee
