**44 MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING**

**RESOLVED**

#### **45 CHAIR'S ANNOUNCEMENTS**

#### **46 MEMBERSHIP OF THE POLICE AND CRIME PANEL**

The Chair outlined the process followed by the five member Recruitment Panel that had been established following the resignation of Mr Evan Morris MBE from the Panel. She noted that four excellent candidates had been interviewed for the vacant position and that the Recruitment Panel were recommending that Prof. Barry Godfrey be appointed to the Panel.

#### **RESOLVED**

- 1 That Professor Barry Godfrey be appointed to the Panel with his term of office running from 8<sup>th</sup> February 2025 to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2029.
- 2 That the Panel's Secretariat bring a report to the Annual Meeting in June 2025 to make recommendations clarifying the position of co-opted Panel members should they not serve a full term, with the Panel's Procedure Rules being amended accordingly.

#### **47 PANEL'S WORK PROGRAMME**

#### **50 POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONER'S PROPOSED PRECEPT: 2025/26**

The Commissioner described the consultation exercise that he had undertaken on his proposed precept for 2025/26 before outlining his proposals. He took detailed questions from Panel members on a range of issues related to the proposed precept.

## **RESOLVED**

That the Commissioner's proposed precept for 2025/26 be supported, with the recommendation that the Panel receive quarterly performance reports.

### **51 POLICE AND CRIME COMMISSIONER'S DRAFT POLICE AND CRIME PLAN**

The Chair thanked the Commissioner for the informal briefings that he had provided to the Panel on the development of his proposed Police and Crime Plan. The Commissioner outlined the process that had been adopted to develop the draft plan and the rationale behind his proposals. The Commissioner took questions from Panel members on a range of issues relevant to the draft Police and Crime Plan.

That the Commissioner's draft Police and Crime Plan be supported.
