Decision in the matter of: War Memorial Grants

Decision: That the War Memorial Grants listed in the Appendix attached to this Notice be awarded, declined, or deferred as indicated, with the exception of that for Bollington War Memorial Fund which was deferred until mid-July when it would be reconsidered.

Background: Cheshire East Council has received various applications for war memorial grants to be considered in line with the Council's Policy for the Allocation of War Memorial Grants. Each grant application is outlined in the report, as is the reason for the recommendation in respect of that application.

All of the proposed grants can be funded from within existing budgets approved as part of the Council's Budget for 2014/15.

The aim of the grants is to assist the funding of the repair and refurbishment of First World War memorials across the Borough in order to commemorate the anniversary of the start and end of the First World War.

In repairing and refurbishing these important community monuments, it is anticipated that there will be increased local community involvement and additional events planned around these monuments.

At the meeting the decision recommended in respect of the grant to Bollington War Memorial Fund was changed to one of deferral until mid-July in order to allow time for the memorial to be transferred to Bollington Parish Council which wished to take over responsibility for its maintenance and upkeep.
