Marton Neighbourhood Plan - Decision to Make the Plan

Decision: That approval be given for the Marton Neighbourhood Plan to be

made, and to form part of the Development Plan for Cheshire East.

Background: The Marton Neighbourhood Plan was submitted to the Council in

February 2015, and following a statutory period, proceeded to

Independent Examination.

Jill Kingaby BSc (Econ) MSc MRTPI was appointed as the Independent Examiner of the Plan. On reviewing the content of the Plan and the representations received as part of the publication

process, she decided not to hold a public hearing.

Following a successful examination, the Council decided to proceed to Referendum. The Referendum was held on 27 October 2016 and returned a positive vote in favour of the Neighbourhood Plan to help

determine planning applications in the neighbourhood area.

Paragraph 38A(4)(a) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 requires that where half or more of those voting in the Plan referendum vote in favour of the Plan, that the Council make the Neighbourhood Plan and adopt it as part of the Development Plan.
