Specific Delegation	Authority to make decision: This decision has been taken in accordance with Cheshire East Council's Constitution dated July 2023, including the Scheme of Officer Delegation, Chapter 2, Part 5. By a delegation dated 1st January 2018 from the Executive Director of Place to Head of Service Rural and Cultural Economy and a further delegation dated 1st January 2018 from the Head of Service Rural and Cultural Economy to the Public Rights of Way Manager.
	The delegation was considered by the Constitution Committee on 20 September 2018, and by full Council on 18 October 2018 and it was resolved that "approval be granted for the scheme of delegation to be amended to enable the Executive Director Place to determine, in consultation with the Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Public Rights of Way Committee, any Public Path Order applications that are not contested or contentious at the pre-order consultation stage."
Brief Description of Decision	A public path diversion Order be made under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 to divert part of Public Footpath No. 20 in the Parish of Buerton on grounds that the Cheshire East Borough Council is satisfied that it is necessary to do so in order to enable development to be carried out.
	The proposal has been put forward by the Public Rights of Way team on behalf of Mr Geoff Blood of Hankins Heys Farm, as a response to a planning application that has been approved by the Council's Planning Department, for 'Conversion of Barns to Three Dwellings at Lower College Fields Farm, Audlem Road, Woore, CW3 9RW' as detailed within planning reference 22/0523N.

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Reasons for the Decision and alternatives considered	It is considered that it is necessary to divert part of Public Footpath No. 20 in the Parish of Buerton as illustrated on Plan No. TCPA/075A, to allow for the conversion of barns to three dwellings at Lower College Fields Farm, Audlem Road, Woore, CW3 9RW, as detailed within planning reference 22/0523N. <i>Alternative options considered</i> Not applicable – this is a non-executive matter.
Member consultation and interests declared	Councillor Rachel Bailey has been consulted and has confirmed that she has no objection to the proposed diversion. Councillors David Browne and Laura Crane, Chair and Vice Chair of the Highways and Transport Committee confirmed their agreement with the recommendations in the report on 22 <sup>nd</sup> November 2023.
Significant Decision	No
Legal Implications	Once an Order is made it may be the subject of objections. If objections are not withdrawn, this removes the power of the Local Authority to confirm the Order itself, and may lead to a hearing or Public Inquiry. It follows that the Committee decision may be confirmed or not confirmed. This process may involve additional legal support and resources.
