





Gawsworth: boundary in Gawsworth Moss area



Matters to decide

The Sub-Committee has already decided that there should be a two-Member 'Bollington & Rainow' ward that includes Bollington and the parishes of Rainow and Pott Shrigley.

However, the Sub-Committee still needs to agree on the Macclesfield Tytherington Borough ward's boundary with the proposed Bollington & Rainow ward, and on the boundaries between the Macclesfield wards.

Two options are presented. The following slide summarises the differences between these options in terms of:

- numbers of seats allocated to each Macclesfield ward;
- the Macclesfield Tytherington Borough ward's boundary with Bollington & Rainow.

Summary of how the options differ in terms of seat allocations and the Macclesfield Tytherington Borough ward boundary with Bollington & Rainow

Option	Difference from current seat allocation for Macclesfield	Tytherington boundary with Bollington & Rainow				
1	Tytherington reduced to 1 seat	Southern boundary of Tytherington Business Park				
2	New 'West' ward (name to be agreed) has 3 seats*	Silk Road (A523)				

*Under Option 2, the 'West' ward would consist of:

- all of the current Broken Cross & Upton Borough ward except for the part of 4AF2 east of Prestbury Road;
- all of the current West & Ivy ward;
- and polling district 4GET (the part of Local Plan site LPS 18 that was moved from Henbury Parish Council to Macclesfield Town Council as part of the Community Governance Review changes in 2023).












Close-up of Macclesfield warding in 4AA2 (Springwood Way area), under Option 1



Close-up of Bollington & Rainow warding in 4AA2 (Springwood Way area), under Option 1


















Close-up of Macclesfield Tytherington boundary with Bollington & Rainow under Option 2








Close-up of boundary between Macclesfield's Tytherington and West wards (division of 4AF2) under Option 2

Macclesfield: potential warding, involving 3-Member 'West' ward: close-up of Tytherington-West boundary (Prestbury Road) and division of 4AF2


