Neighbourhood area applications must be made in accordance with Regulation 5 of the Regulations. Any qualifying body (including a parish council) is entitled to initiate the process. Applications must be publicised in compliance with Regulation 6 of those regulations. Section 61G of the 1990 Act sets out the requirements for determining applications for an area to be designated a neighbourhood area. In determining an application, the authority must have regard to the desirability of designating the whole area of a parish council as a neighbourhood area and the desirability of maintaining the existing boundaries of areas already designated as neighbourhood areas.

Neighbourhood Development Plans and Orders, which may follow the making of a Neighbourhood Area, are prepared in accordance with the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended by the Localism Act 2011) and the Regulations.

Financial Implications

The designation of the Haslington neighbourhood area for Haslington Parish will not incur direct costs to the Council in itself, however this application, and future applications, will require input and time from officers both in the Strategic Planning team and from other services. Support will be made available to Haslington Parish Council toward preparing the Haslington Neighbourhood Plan. This support is being made available within existing budgets. There are also other grants available from Cheshire East Council that may be awarded and from external bodies such as Locality.

	At a later stage direct costs will be incurred as the
	Council is required to hold an independent
	examination and a referendum on the proposed
	Haslington Neighbourhood Plan. Under the
	Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations
	2012, the costs of this examination and referendum
	are required to be met by the Council. Such costs
	will be met through existing budgets and through
	grant funding from central government.


