Reasons for the Decision and alternatives considered	 For works to upgrade the level crossing infrastructure to be carried out by Network Rail it is necessary to close the above-mentioned roads in Cheshire East. The alternative route will be via Station Road, Pratchitts Row, Hospital Street, London Road Roundabout, London Road, Newcastle Road, Elwood Way, Peter De Stapleigh Way, Audlem Road, Wellington Road and vice versa which is considered the most suitable route. It is anticipated that the works will commence on Saturday 12th July 2025 and will be completed by Sunday 31st August 2025.
