<b>Brief Description of Decision</b>	<p>Being satisfied that traffic should be prohibited to facilitate works, to give public notice of and make a temporary road closure order under s14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and all other enabling powers to prohibit traffic on Waterside, Macclesfield outside Orchard House for a period of 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner.</p>		
<b>Reasons for the Decision and alternatives considered</b>	<p>For sewer repair to be carried out by United Utilities Ltd it is necessary to close Waterside, Macclesfield outside Orchard House.</p>
