Reasons for the Decision and alternatives considered	Internal Ref: 24 015, C1418 The decision to make a direct award to the current provider on the current framework was to allow for cost savings by avoiding increased charges and to provide the flexibility to review current agency worker procurement arrangements annually if deemed necessary. Two alternative options were considered including a) An alternative model and full procurement of a new provider on a new framework; and b) The same model and full procurement of a new, or current, provider on a new framework. The two alternative options were rejected due to the increased costs and the time and resources (indirect costs) of conducting a full procurement exercise. Making a direct award to the current					

	provider will mean that there is no change to the agency margin charges, therefore there will be no impact on the council's Medium Term Financial Strategy.

Financial Implications	Costs for agency staff are attributed to each Service/department budget as required. In some instances, insufficient budget exists to meet the full cost of the staff being paid from those budgets with agency costs contributing to overspends being reported by some services. Making a direct award will avoid a full re procurement exercise and additional costs both in terms of resourcing the procurement process and the subsequent increase in the prices charged by the MSP and agencies under a new framework/contract.					
	Expenditure on Agency Staff is currently circa £14.85 million per annum; therefore, this contract has the potential of costing £44.6 million over three years if spend continues at current rates.					
	Spend on agency staff has increased from £10m in 2021/22 to £14.85m in 2022/23.					
	Work is underway to reduce reliance and therefore spend on agency workers and this work will be ongoing. If that process is successful, it is anticipated that the overall cost of the contract will reduce over the three years.
