It is proposed that an application process for 2016/17 only is established and promoted to all community radio stations, following which the budget will be moved into the Community Grants Scheme.							
	A scoping exercise has shown that it is unusual for community radio stations to be funded through local authorities. Those that do receive funding do so through council community grant schemes for specific initiatives.
