## 2 Deputy Police & Crime Commissioner: Confirmation Hearing

- 2.2 In accordance with the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011, the appointment of a Deputy Commissioner requires a confirmation hearing to be undertaken by the Police and Crime Panel. The Confirmation Hearing must take place within three weeks of the Commissioner notifying the Panel of the proposed candidate.
