Grounds for License Review


After taking the White Horse Public House to Court in August 2016 for License Review due to excessive noise and general rowdiness outside the pub with smokers stood on Pillory street it was pleasing that for many months the problem of late night noise with punters from the White Horse Public House had gone away. Measures put in place by the pub, extra security staff and awareness of their neighbours was noticeably different. During 2015 and 2016 I was in a relationship with a woman from Stoke so not often at home on Pillory Street but that relationship ended in June 2016, so I've been home most nights ever since.

As a professional Railway Manager my job takes me all over the country often with midweek nights away however I'm always at home on a Sunday night and up early for work Monday morning compiling reports for the Executive Team first thing.

Friday and Saturday nights on Pillory Street are often boisterous with people passing along the street on the way home from a night out always without issue.

Sunday nights are the issue with the White Horse Public House being the only pub in town open after 11pm so it attracts Students who I guess don't get up for work on a Monday morning.

At 02:15 Monday 17th July I was awoken by revellers coming out of the White Horse screaming and shouting as they walked passed by apartment. I photographed the individuals to record the event forwarding copies of the pictures to Cheshire East Council Licensing Department and Tess the landlady of the White Horse. Cheshire East Council acknowledged my email saying they would speak with the landlady accordingly. To say I was exhausted at work on that Monday was an understatement. I saw Tess a few days later and we chatted about the rowdy punters most of which she knew by name after looking at my pictures! Tess went on to say she'd started getting complaints from other residences in the Town Square / Mill Street of people making excessive noise after leaving her pub in the early hours. She said she struggled to control people after they left her pub but had asked her Local Police Liaison Officer for a police presence on a Monday morning like other licensed establishments have on a Friday or Saturday night. I asked Tess about the drunken state of the people I had photographed and she replied she just serves them water if they appeared drunk in a bid to sober them up so they can all go home together and not have single girls walking home alone.




It's a shame the picture doesn't show,the people shouting and swearing at the top of their voices.

At 02:10 Monday 7th August I was awoken by shouting. I looked out my bedroom window and saw a crowd stood outside the White Horse Public House with one girl very agitated swearing at the top of her voice. I switched my phone onto video to record the events. The girl swearing walked down Pillory Street towards my apartment still sweating at the top of her voice with appropriately fifteen other people young men and woman and then it kicked off with several young men punching each other. This is when I stopped filming and called the Police to report fighting on the street. Police reference 65 / 07082017. Within a few minutes a single Police car arrived on the scene. The single Police Officer was faced with approx fifteen people brawling, one man dressed in dark clothing was put in the back of the police car. Then another Police car arrived again with a single Police Officer. Within twenty minutes the situation was calmed by the Police presence and most people had dispersed. I couldn't tell if the man on the back of the police car had been detained or not. I rang the police back to advise I had full video footage on my iPhone of the disturbance for their reference and they said someone would be in touch in days to come.

I emailed Cheshire East Council at 3am to advise them what had happened. I also text messaged Tess from the White Horse Public House who advised she had requested the Police to be proactive and be outside for closing time but no one had turned up. She advised me that she called the Police herself on seeing the fighting start outside her pub. She also advised she had banned approx twenty people that evening for making excessive noise in the street.

I have no problem with the White Horse Public House as a pub but the need for it to be open until 02:00 Monday morning and 02:00 weekday nights is not needed for a small historical market town with residence all around. Young predominantly students getting drunk and being served alcohol until they are ready for a fight is not needed in the conservation area that is Pillory Street. To note there is rarely issues on a Friday and Saturday night.

Needless to say Monday 8th August I was exhausted at work thanks to the antics of the minority spoiling it for other and giving the town a bad reputation.
