#### Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

#### **Prevention of Crime and Disorder**

- 1. The Licence Holder/Designated Premises Supervisor shall build relationships with local Police and Community Officers. Strong relationships continue with the Local Police and Community Officers. We are part of both the Pub Watch scheme and Arcangel.
- 2. The pub watch radio scheme shall be utilised.
- 3. Staff at the premises shall be trained, well selected and well informed. Staff are all trained, 3 of whom have Personal licences.
- 4. Qualified, trained and experienced door staff shall be employed if necessary.
- 5. A clear message shall be projected that drugs, violence and crime are not acceptable at any level.
- 6. Excessive or irresponsible drinking shall be discouraged, soft drinks and free tap water is available and we have a list of taxi numbers which we are happy to provide to customers or call taxis on their behalf.

#### **Public Safety**

- 7. Alcohol will not be served to anyone who appears to be drunk or to anyone on behalf of anyone who is drunk. The bar staff are trained and are aware of this. They have all had to sign on to the arcangel guidelines and policies. Violence is not tolerated at any level and if this occurs the managers are aware of how to deal with this promptly and efficiently so as to cause minimum risk of danger to the public.
- 8. Drink driving materials and taxi numbers shall be on display at the premises.
- 9. Staff shall be informed, trained and aware of activities in the premises which may be harmful to members of the public.

#### **Prevention of Public Nuisance**

- 10. The management of the premises shall create and enforce that a clear understanding of anti social behaviour will not be tolerated. We send out a clear message that we will not tolerate abusive or anti social behaviours to ourselves or to our customers at any time.
- 11. No disposal of refuse including bottles outside the premises or deliveries made to the premises between 2100 and 0700.

#### **Protection of Children from Harm**

- 12. No person under the age of 18 years will be allowed in the bar area.
- 13. No alcohol will be served to anyone under 18 years.
- 14. If any doubt of age exists, service will be refused.

- 15. No person under 18 will be allowed on the premises after 9pm.
- 16. No person under 18 will be employed in the bar or restaurant. Staff serving alcohol shall be over 18 years of age and familiar with the procedures required and shall ask for ID if a customer looks under the age of 21.
- 17. We have a challenge 25 policy in place. If in doubt service is refused.

#### **General – All Licensing Objectives**

- 18. There shall be no admission to the premises for persons under the age of 18 years unless accompanied by an adult for the purpose of taking a table meal in the restaurant area.
- 19. Non-alcoholic beverages shall be available, including drinking water free of charge.
- 20. Where there is provided in the Premises an entertainment for children, or an entertainment at which the majority of the persons attending are children, then, if the number of children attending the entertainment exceeds one hundred, it shall be the duty of the person providing the entertainment to station and keep stationed wherever necessary a sufficient number of adult attendants, properly instructed as to their duties, to prevent more children or other persons being admitted to the building, or to any part thereof, than the building or part can properly accommodate, and to control the movement of the children and other persons admitted while entering and leaving the building or any part thereof, and to take all other reasonable precautions for the safety of the children
- 21. Where the occupier of the Premises permits, for hire or reward, the Premises to be used for the Purpose of an entertainment, he shall take all reasonable steps to secure the observance of the provisions of condition 19 above.

#### Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the Licensing Authority

- 1. All recorded music will be background music.
- 2. The door behind the downstairs back doors shall be closed when the back door is open.
- 3. All doors, windows, skylights and emergency doors will be kept closed whilst any type of music is being played after 22.00 except for access and egress to the premises.
- 4. On occasions of national or international significance or charitable events an extension will be permitted of an additional hour on up to twelve occasions only per year with a minimum of seven days' notice to the Police and Licensing Authority and with an absolute veto for the Police and the Environmental Health Department in respect of any of these occasions.
- 5. If a band is playing on any night they will ask customers to leave quietly.
- 6.Additional patrols will take place by members of staff, internally and externally to limit noise pollution when entertainment is being offered within the premises.
